

## Swansea University Fulton Fellowship

### Subject areas

Awarded for any of the priority subject areas:

- Education
  - Health and related social sciences
  - Information technology
  - Information management
  - STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics)
- subjects
- Sustainable development
  - University development and management

**Eligibility:** Applicants must be professional or academic staff of, or a nominee of, an [ACU member university](#) (external nominees should be working in industry, commerce or public service in a [Commonwealth country](#)). As the fellowship is tenable at [Swansea University](#) in the UK, this fellowship is **not** open to applicants who work in the UK.

**The Fellowship:** Tenable at [Swansea University](#), UK.

**Tenure of Fellowship:** The tenure of the fellowship must be for a period of less than six months, and travel must be completed by 1 August 2017.

**Value of Fellowship:** Up to 5000 GBP and intended to cover:

- international economy return airfare and other travel costs
- medical insurance and visa fees
- board and lodging fees
- research costs

**Other terms and conditions:** Fellowships are **not intended for degree courses, or for immediately postdoctoral programmes**. The ACU cannot arrange Fellows' attachments, travel or accommodation, nor can it work out itineraries for them.

Applicants should be aware that Titular Fellowships allow for small scale conference or course attendance within a wider programme but that applications will not be considered where the primary or sole purpose is the attendance of the applicant at a conference or course.

Fellows are required to submit a 1000-2,500 word report within three months of the end of the Fellowship.

**How to apply:** Apply [here](#). Applicants must submit a proposal for the Fellowship and provide proof of support for their fellowship from their host institution as well as from the Executive Head of their home institution.

Applications close on 15 May 2016 at midnight BST.
